We appreciate the dozen or so faithful who settle into the rocking chairs on the porch each week and the faithful boaters, numbering from one to sixteen, depending on the weather and the smoothness of the water, who come out to enjoy the music and the beauty of the sunset, but we can't count the numbers of those on docks and front porches around the Lake who enjoy the music as well.

Eight concerts have been planned for this year with the last scheduled for August 26th.

Our equipment continues to serve us well, and the purchase of an additional twenty-six CD's this past Fall at the modest cost of \$52.00 has substantially expanded our CD library collection.

Once again I repeat my plea for any interested individuals to join the Music Committee. Without a working committee the future of the Sunday Evening Lake Concerts is problematic. Now is the time to step forward and help plan for the future.

Lisa and I have enjoyed hosting these concerts and look forward to the possibility of another fine season of Lake Concerts next year.
