In 2013, the five Tuesday night concerts led by flutist and Artistic Director Karen Kevra will again offer both traditional and innovative music for all ages, performed in the pitch-perfect Sanctuary of the Greensboro United Church of Christ in Greensboro. Among the standout ensembles performing in the past two years on the SMfG series were the Borromeo String Quartet, the Walsh-Drucker-Cooper Trio, the Barenberg Bluegrass Quartet, and a woodwind sextet with piano, featuring works by Poulenc and Barber.

We invite you to join us for the 2013 concert series on Tuesday nights on July 16, 23 and 30, and on August 6 and 13. Subscriptions and tickets may be ordered in advance on the website, by mail, and in person at the GUUC on concert nights.
