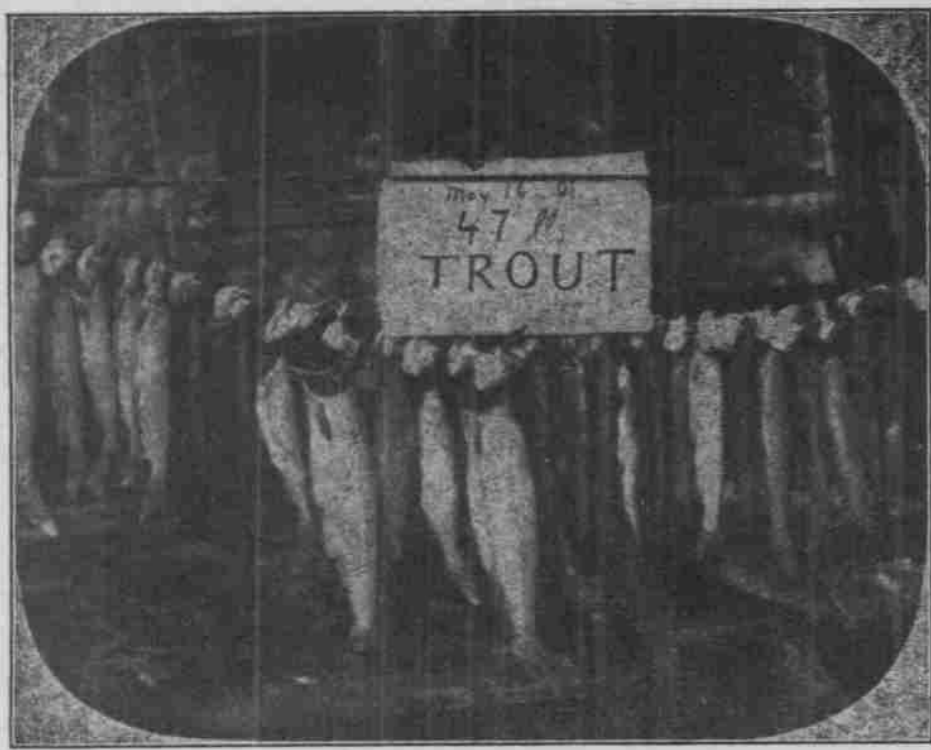

LECTURES AND ENTERTAINMENTS
Some Noted Men Have Addressed Greensboro People.

The lectures and entertainments which the summer residents enjoy at Lake Caspian are not less varied than the scenery which the lake and mountains afford. They range from the highest type of cultural lecture, delivered by such men as Dr. Bliss Perry of Harvard, Judge Wendell Phillips Stafford of Washington, D. C., and George B. Maloin, associate editor of "Everybody's Magazine," through various forms of musical entertainments to the minstrel show. Among the summer campers at Greensboro there is a large number of people of unusual musical ability, the male quartette, the mixed quartette, the double quartette, the chorus, the orchestra, the string quartette, and soloists, both vocal and instrumental, furnish music both sacred and secular, of a quality that is not excelled by many professional organizations. The regular musical entertainment is one of the features of the season. Another is the play, sometimes pastoral, sometimes a drama, and sometimes a minstrel show, in which young and old, staid college professors, judges, business men, college students and town's people vie with each other in the display of histrionic talent.

The purpose of the various lectures and entertainments is not simply amusement. The proceeds are devoted to benevolent uses, such as the church work of the village, the public library or the Mountain View Country club. One of the most beneficial results is in fostering and promoting the social and democratic spirit so characteristic of the cosmopolitan community that gathers every year on these shores of Lake Caspian.
