



GRANTS COMMITTEE REPORT  
August 4, 2021

**Grant Committee Mission Statement: We support town initiatives and organizations that enhance our Greensboro community for both year-round and seasonal residents.**

For our previous fiscal year ending June 30, 2021, the GA Grants Committee only awarded 6 grants totaling \$6,500 to town projects and community service applicants. Applications were down due to many organizations and projects being put hold on during the pandemic.

This spring applications rebounded due to the decline of the pandemic and the return of community activity. For the fiscal year starting July 1, 2021, the Grants Committee received 15 applications and awarded 12 grants totaling \$13,250 (see the list below). The Grants Committee will reconvene in late August to consider 3 pending applications.
